

# PSCDC 2024 Year In Review



## Economic Impact

- Worked with 42 industry partners
- Conducted 21 business outreach visits
- Awarded \$2,740,000 in housing grants, including More Housing Now, Capacity Grant & HNA
- Invested \$3M locally by employing local builder, contractors & suppliers for workforce housing



## Workforce Development

- Employed 55 students in the Summer Internship Program
- Sponsored 13 new Commercial Driver's License graduates across 2 classes
- Assisted 10 adults in work-based learning with new employment opportunities
- Secured additional \$100K grant for 2025



## Broadband

- Funded and installed backup generator for downtown CNL building
- Secured \$2M Region 9 for high-end CNL electronics, including \$350K for Archuleta County
- Participated in BEAD funding to expand broadband in all of Aspen Springs
- Sent task order to CDOT for Wolf Creek fiber



## Main Street Program

- Launched Cone Zone Care Program
- Secured \$250K CDOT Revitalizing Main Streets grant
- Achieved national accreditation from Main Street America
- Boosted downtown business with \$4K direct support
- Formed MET Task Force & secured 225 public parking spaces downtown



## Workforce Housing

- Selected contractor and started construction of 10 single-family homes
- Awarded funding for Chris Mtn II & Trails subdivisions
- Awarded Capacity grant & hired MJH
- Awarded \$550K in Prop 123 for housing project
- Completed construction of 10 single-family homes for 100% AMI
- Sold two homes
